## EDUCATIONAL GRANTS

Each year the Stanford Trustees make grants to suitable applicants who are about to commence one of the following:

1. a recognised Craft Apprenticeship; or
2. a recognised Higher Education Course, or an equivalent professional qualification.
3. A grant may be provided for Further Education studies where all course requirements are not met by the local authority.

*Please note: Grants are not normally given for 'A' level studies.*

Applicants should be under 25 years of age and resident, or have parents who reside, in one of the following villages: Laceby, Irby-upon-Humber, Aylesby, Bradley, or Barnoldby-le-Beck (the area of benefit of the Trust).

Grants will normally only be given **once** during an approved course (usually in the first year).

Grants are given to help cover the initial cost of tools, in the case of apprenticeships, or books or specialised equipment, etc., in the case of academic courses.

Dear Student,

Each year, the Stanford Trust makes grants to young people under 25, who live in one of the following villages:

Laceby,  
Irby-upon-Humber,  
Aylesby,  
Bradley, or  
Barnoldby-le-Beck

The grants are available if you are under 25 when you commence one of the following options:

1. Further education (e.g. GNVQs, HNCs, (but not A levels)
2. Go to University or College
3. Enter into an Apprenticeship

The grants are not means-tested, so no-one will approach your parents to ask about their income or approach you if you have a part-time job. Money is made available each year and awards of £200 to a maximum of £325 granted. These amounts may be adjusted at the discretion of the Trustees. In some of the last few years the number of applicants has fallen, but there is money available if you meet these simple conditions.

The closing date is 1<sup>st</sup> October, and if successful, you should receive a cheque in early December.
